

THE BARN BISTRO

at The Penscot Inn



IN SHIPHAM, nestled between the shoulders of the Mendip hills, sits the Penscot Inn.

It's a place full of charm and character, with a quirky bar with a log fire, comfy chairs and a warm friendly atmosphere, and made distinctive by the newly renovated Barn Bistro, where contemporary style works perfectly against a backdrop of original stone walls and a vaulted ceiling.

The inn was bought by Guy and Sarah 18 months ago. Experienced in the hotel trade, they wanted to make the Penscot Inn a place to be remembered whether you pop in for a midweek drink, a full evening meal - or a night - or two or three or four - in one of its cosy individual rooms.

The informal bar menu features classic steak and kidney pie, steaks and more traditional favourites, while the bistro serves delights such as pork wellington, Spring lamb or sea bass with mange tout, ginger and sesame. The menu changes with the seasons and availability of produce.

On Sundays, a set two or three course meal is available in the bistro and in the bar the normal menu is served with the addition of roast beef with all the trimmings.

The friendly staff and relaxed atmosphere will provide you with an unforgettable stay.
